

## INSTITUTE OF NAVIGATION (ION) GRADUATE AWARD

- DONOR:** Institute of Navigation (ION) Alberta Section
- FIELD OF STUDY:** Satellite based navigation systems
- VALUE:** Canadian dollar equivalent of US \$1,000
- NUMBER:** Two
- DURATION:** One year
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to candidates who at the time of application will be registered full-time in a graduate program in the Department of Geomatics Engineering at the University of Calgary and whose research involves satellite based navigation systems. Candidates will have completed at least two relevant graduate courses with a minimum average of 3.30 on a 4.0 scale, and have demonstrated strong research potential.
- Candidates must be ION members for at least 12 months prior to the application deadline.
- Selection criteria also include interest in the Institute of Navigation (ION) activities, demonstrated by attendance at meetings, awards received, and similar involvement in ION Alberta Section meetings.
- WHERE TENABLE:** University of Calgary, Faculty of Graduate Studies
- NOMINATION PROCESS:** Recommended by Program
- APPLY:** Candidates should apply to the Department of Geomatics Engineering. The application will consist of a letter describing the candidate's academic performance and accomplishments in satellite navigation, proof of ION membership and the candidate's activities with the ION.
