PLAN GROUP TEAM WINS ALOUETTE AWARD OF THE CANADIAN AERONAUTICS AND SPACE INSTITUTE

The CanX-2 team at the University of Calgary has won the Alouette Award for their contributions to the CanX-2 nanosatellite mission. This team is led by Professors Susan Skone and Elizabeth Cannon and includes Professor Kyle O'Keefe, MSc candidate Erin Kahr, MSc graduate Lance de Groot and undergraduate student Michael Swab. The CanX-2 mission was led by the University of Toronto with various academic, industry and government partners participating. The University of Calgary led the GPS radio occultation payload development and implementation for low-cost global atmospheric/ionospheric monitoring.
